Sharing fairly/safely and taking turns during CIP and playing games.

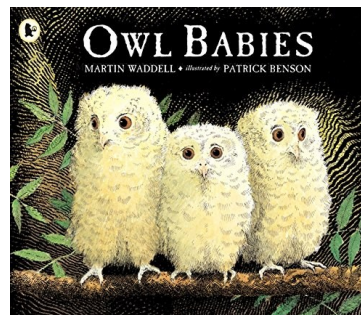
Learning our school reward systems.
